 - curriculum, instruction and assessment, including:
 - differentiated instruction and learners' diverse needs, goals and interests,
 - FLES, immersion, middle school, high school and post-secondary levels,
 - proficiency and proficiency-based methods,
 - technology-enhanced language learning and teaching,
 - research-based learning strategies,
 - heritage language and bilingual education.
 - culture and intercultural competence
 - professional development, and
 - issues related to the teaching and learning of specific languages,

By **September 1, 2019**, please submit to Dr. Brigid Burke, 2020 Report Editor [\[bburke@bgsu.edu\]](mailto:bburke@bgsu.edu) a letter of intent that includes the title, a 250-word abstract, and the names and contact information (phone and email) for all authors.
